

Instructions for Qualatex® Playful Pig Centerpiece

To keep assembly time to a minimum, gather the materials and read through the instructions before beginning.

Labor: About 10 Minutes

Materials:

- 1 30" (76cm) "Playful Pig" Microfoil® Shape 29656
 - 8 11" (28cm) Pink Latex Balloons 43766
 - 1 260Q Pink Latex Balloon 43950
- Qualatex BalloonRibbon™
Weight

Instructions:

1. Inflate four 11" Pink latex balloons to 9" (23cm) and create a 4-balloon cluster (see "4-Balloon Cluster" below). Tie to the weight.
2. Inflate four 11" Pink latex balloons to 6.5" (16.5cm) and create a 4-balloon cluster. Tie this cluster into the cluster in Step 1, rotating it so it nests.
3. Inflate the 30" "Playful Pig" Microfoil, roll up the neck with ribbon, and tie into the cluster in Step 2.
4. Create a Curly 260Q (see "Curly 260Q" below). Make a twist in the middle of the Curly 260Q to create two bubbles. Deflate the knot end and tie, creating a shorter curly "tail." Tie the knot end into the clusters.



Curly 260Q

To make a Curly 260Q, use a cylinder with a band made from an uninflated 260Q tied around it on one end. Stretch out another 260Q by fully inflating it and letting out the air. Slip the end of the 260Q under the band and wrap it around the cylinder, stretching it a little as you go and making sure not to twist or wrinkle the balloon. Then inflate the 260Q and tie.

4-Balloon Cluster

Inflate and size two balloons, then tie the necks together. Repeat to make a second pair, then twist the two pairs together to make a 4-balloon cluster.
